Dr Luis Falcón is a physician, computer scientist, humanitarian, and global advocate dedicated to advancing social medicine, open science, and compassionate healthcare. He holds degrees in Computer Science and Mathematics from California State University, Medicine from IUCS Buenos Aires, and a Master's in Genomics and Medical Genetics from the University of Granada.

In 2009, he founded GNU Solidario, a non-profit organisation focused on social medicine and animal rights, and created GNU Health, the award-winning hospital information system adopted by the United Nations and used worldwide. His research interests span genomics, integrative medicine, and health informatics, including the Global Exposome Project, which studies how environment and lifestyle shape health.
